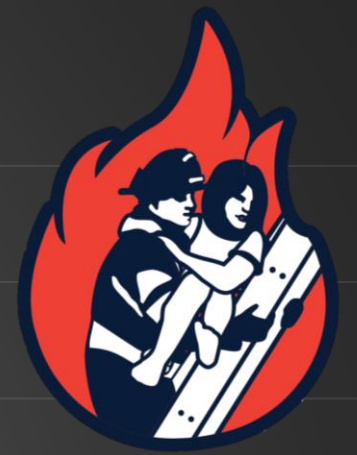
Was the Victim Behind a Closed Door v Survival Rate



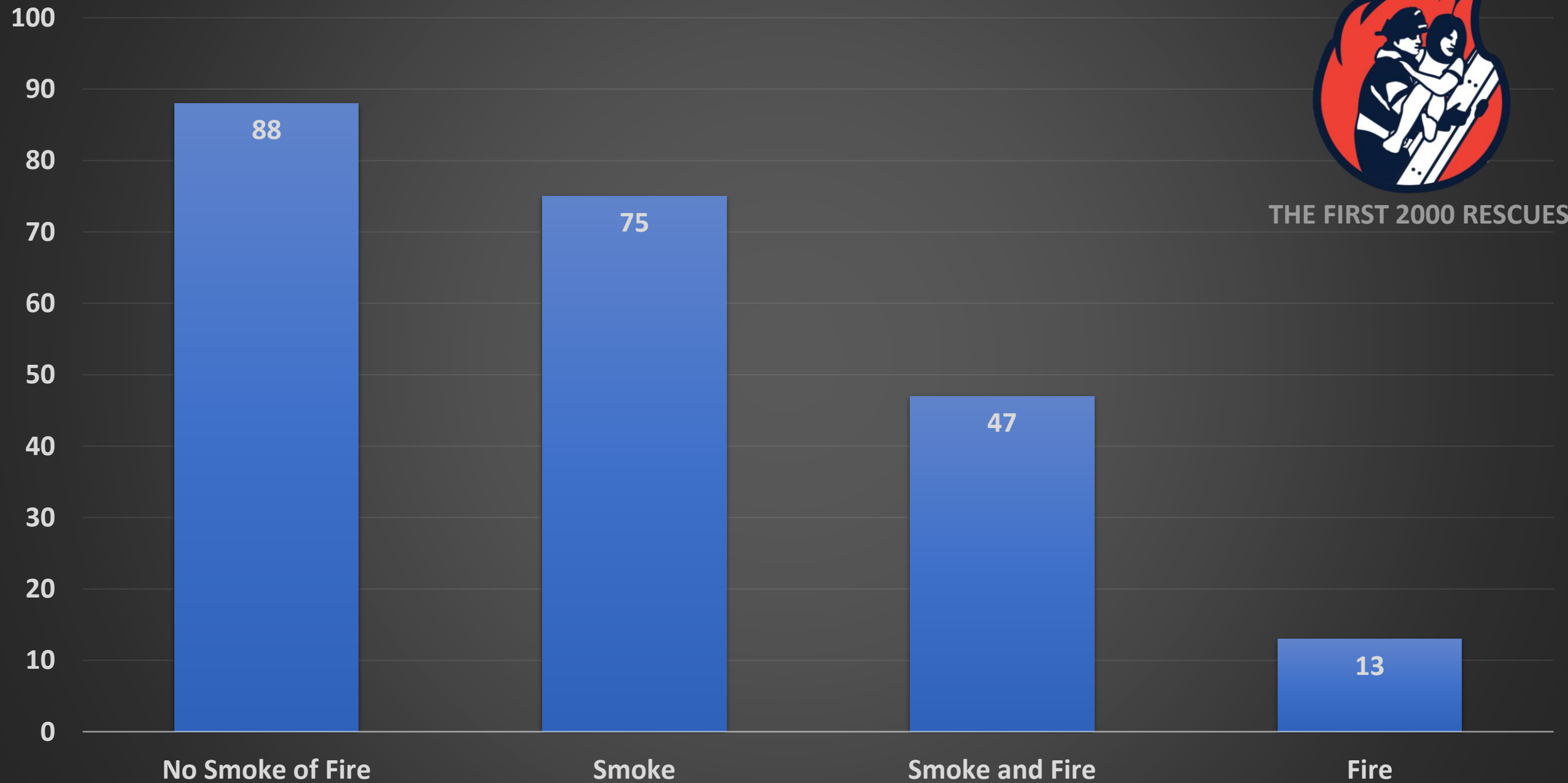

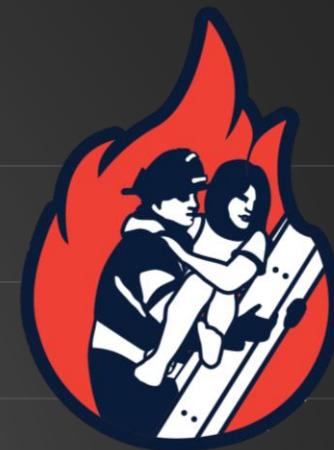
Conditions at Victim Location v Survival Rate



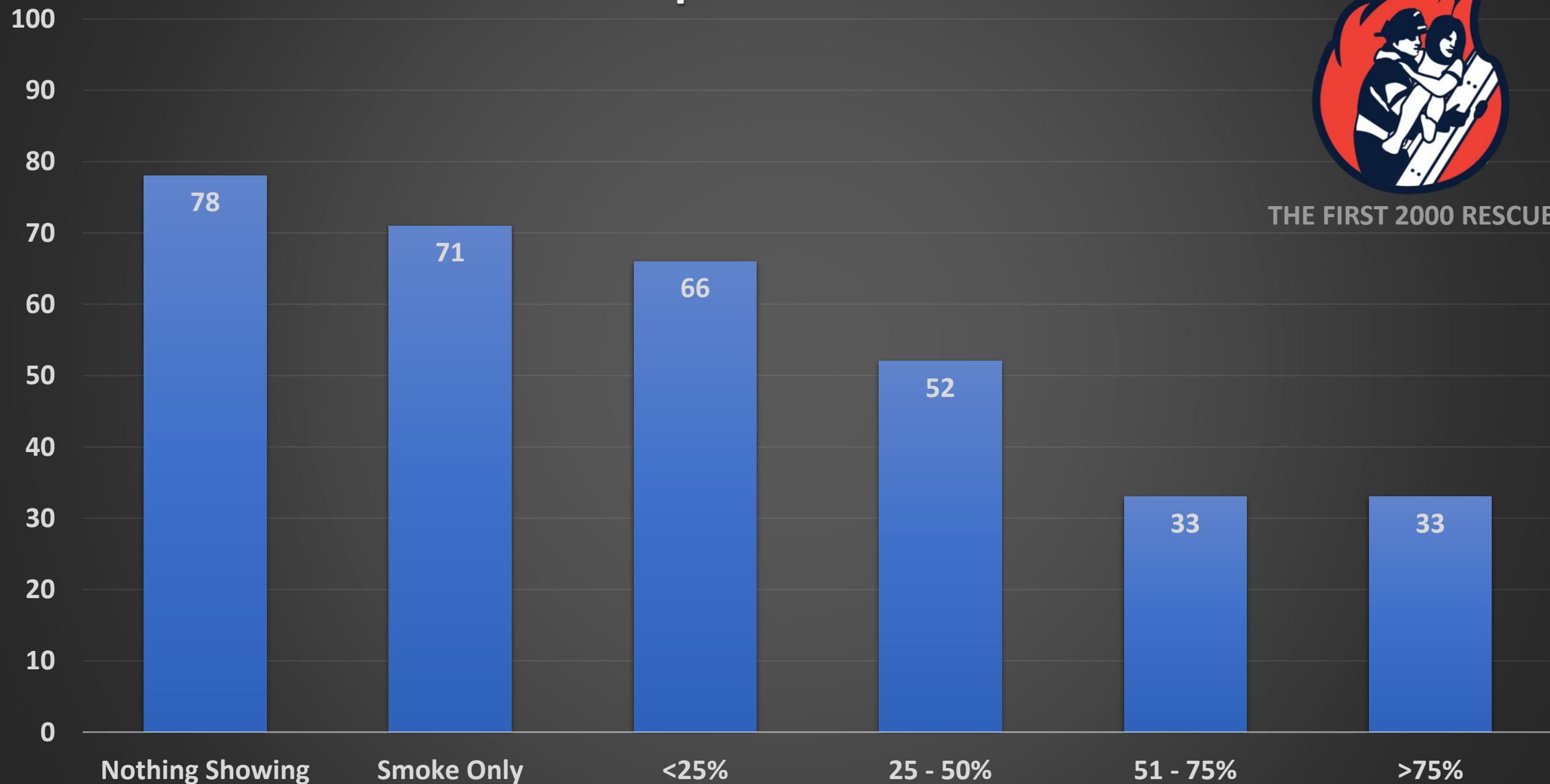

Exterior Conditions Upon Arrival v Survival Rate



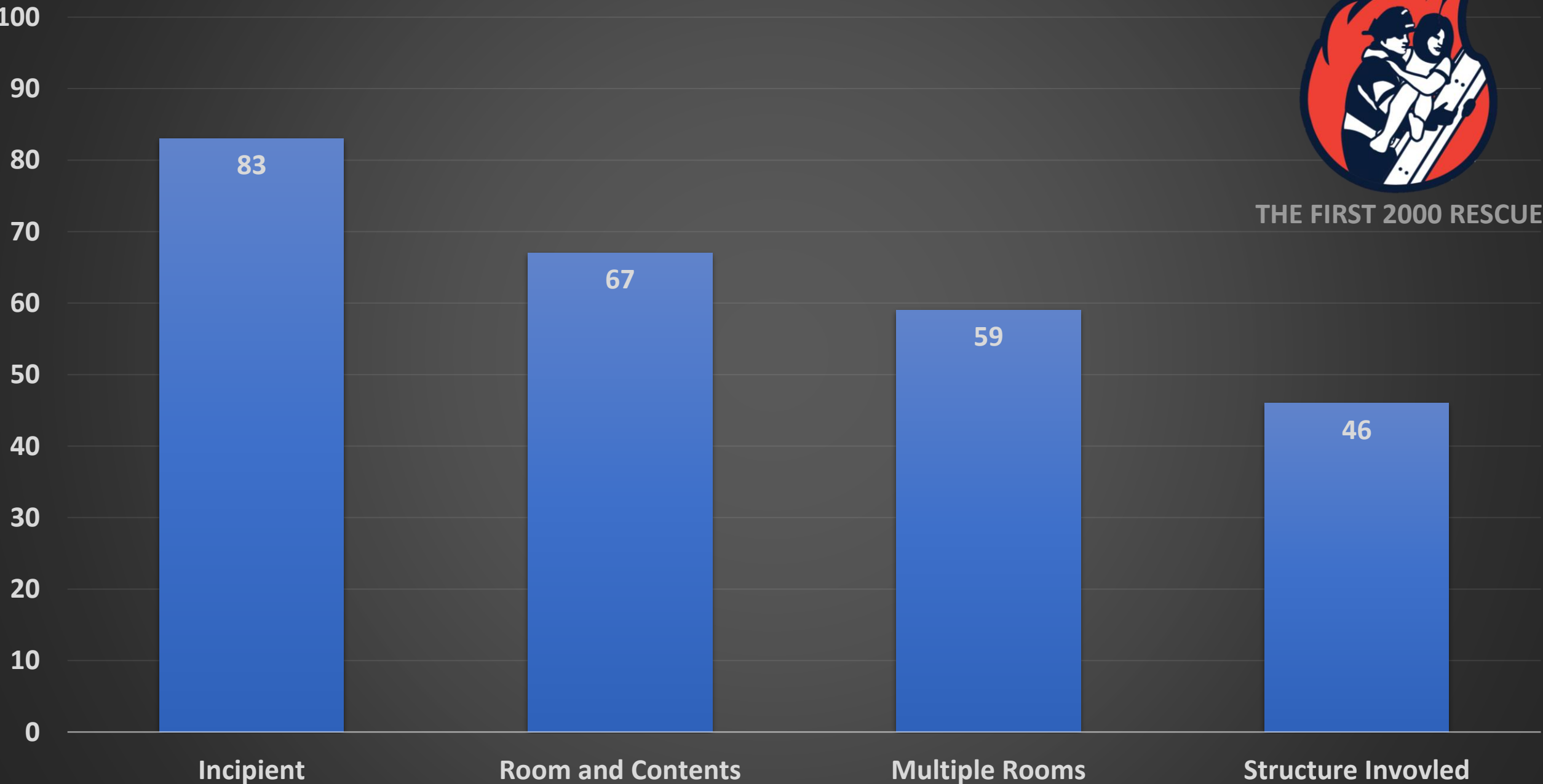

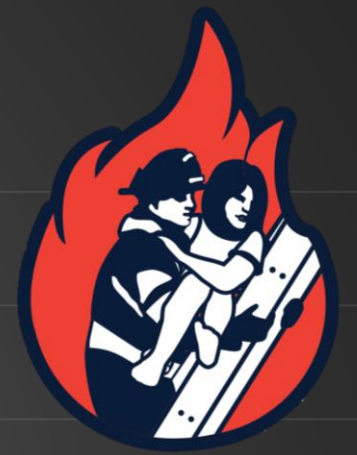
Conditions Upon Entry v Survival Rate



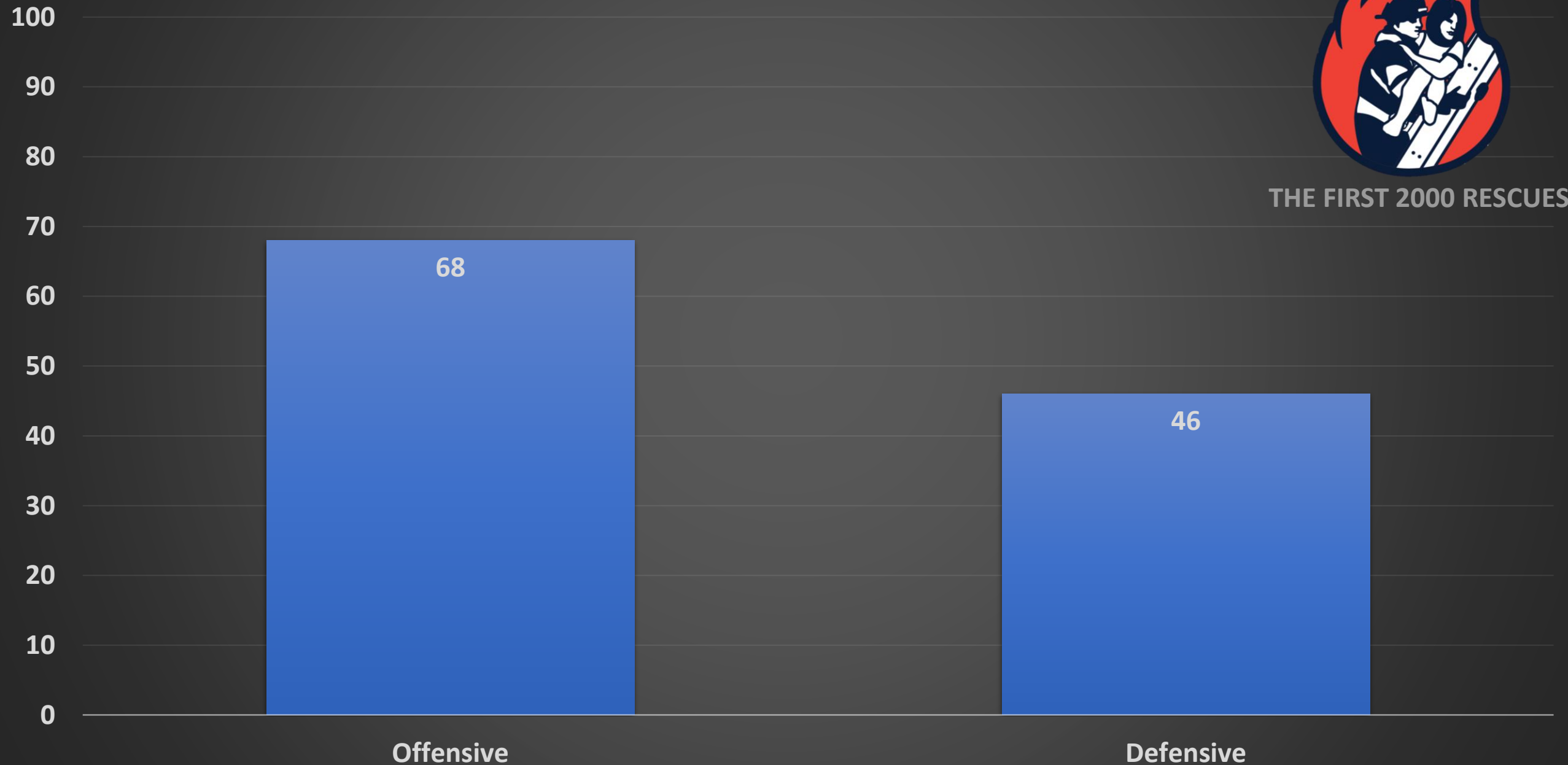

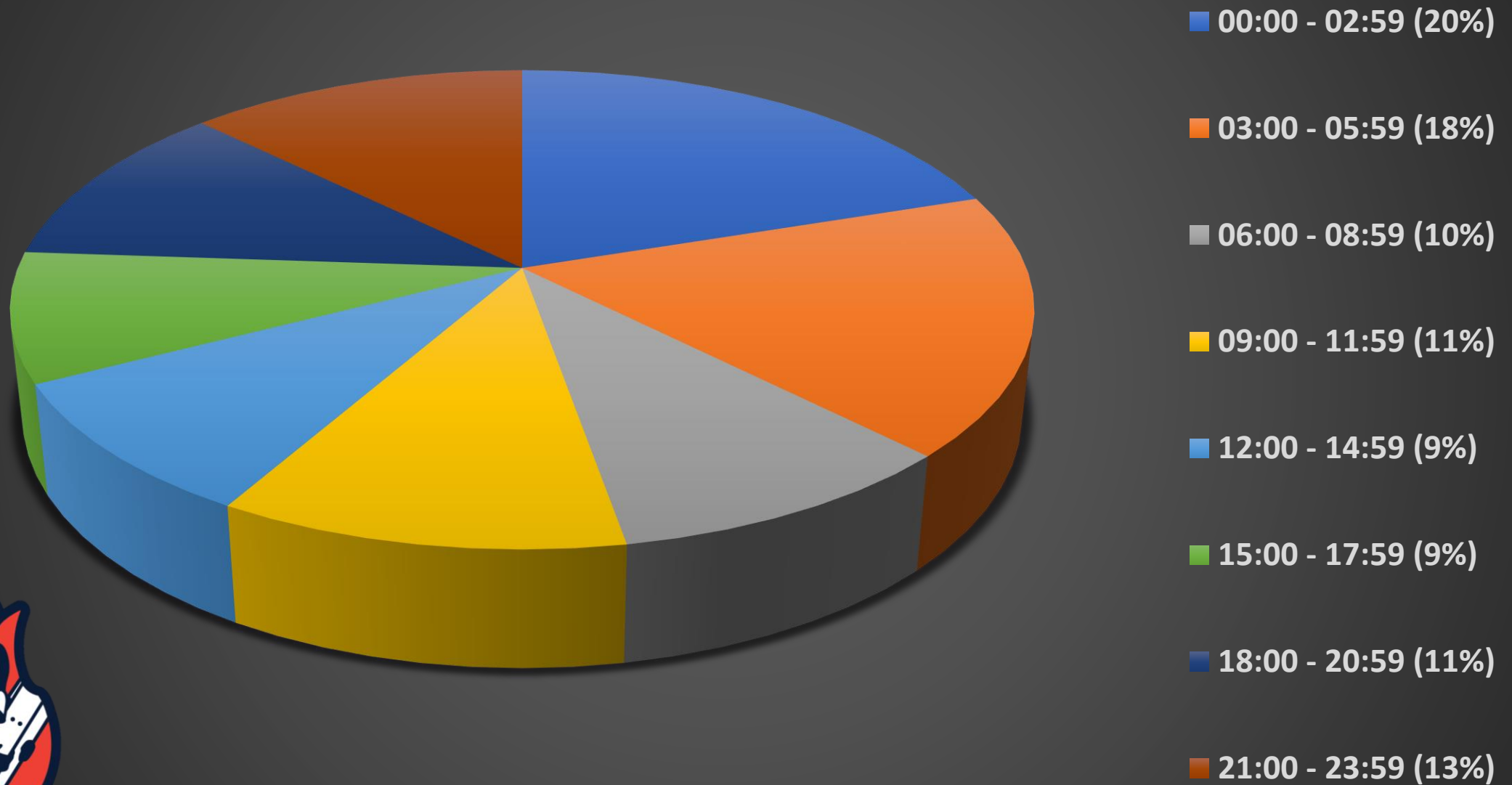
Number of Rescuers Needed for Removal v Survival Rate



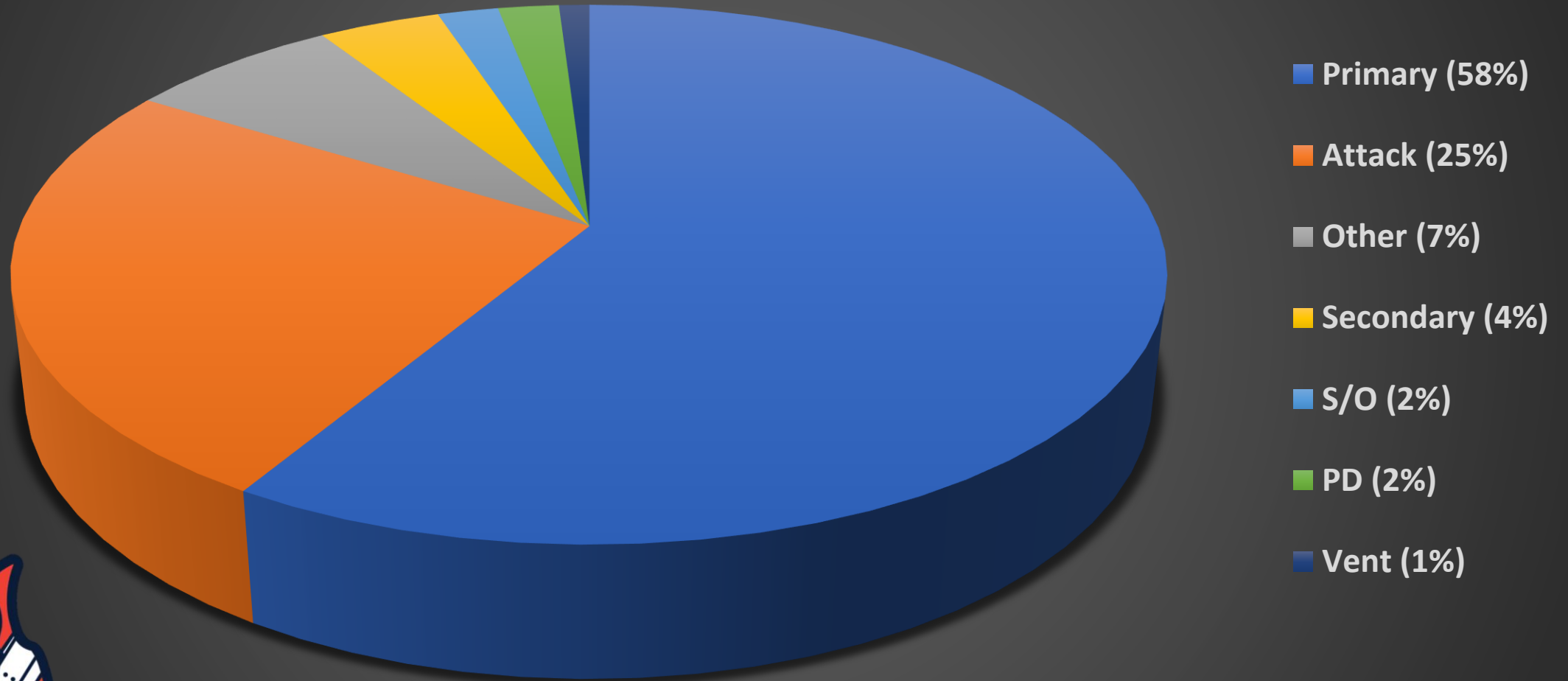

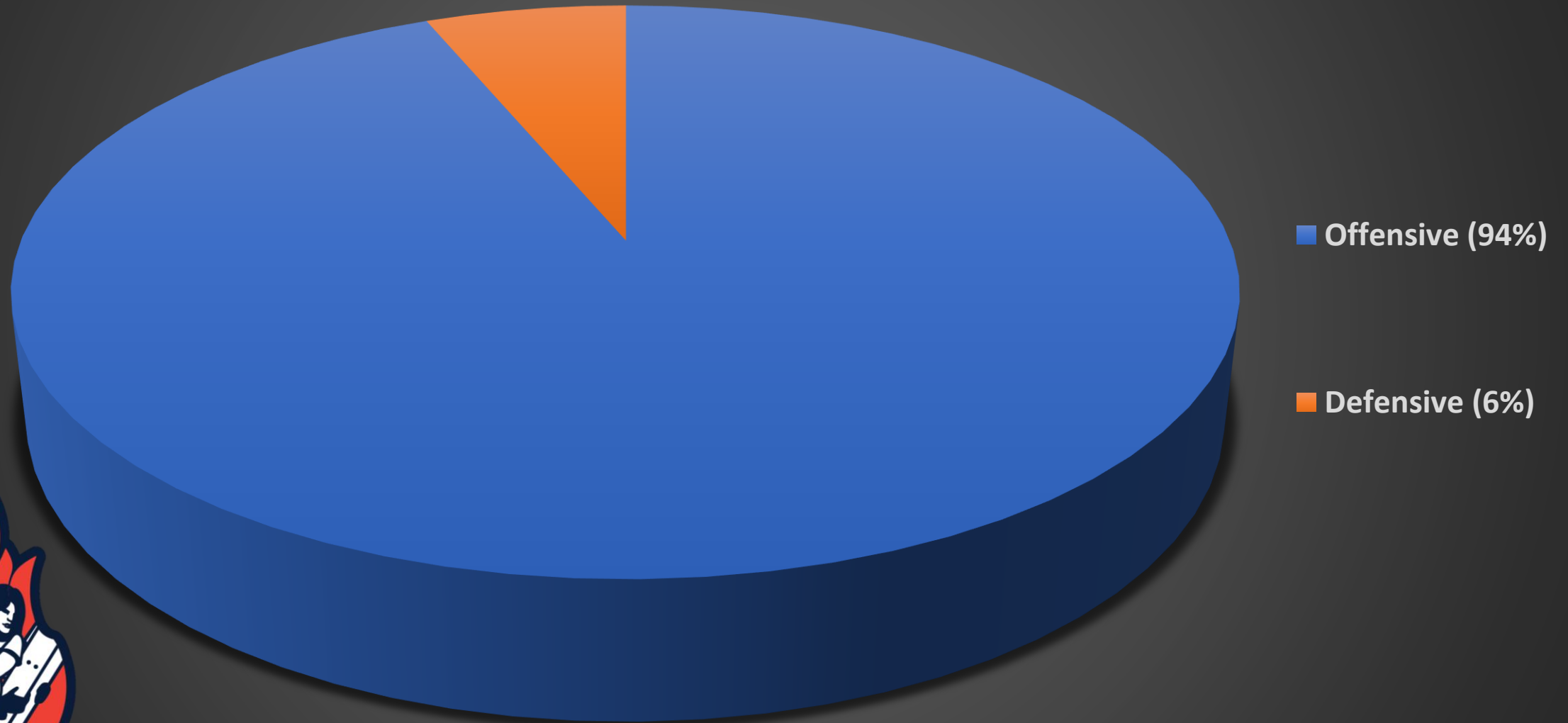

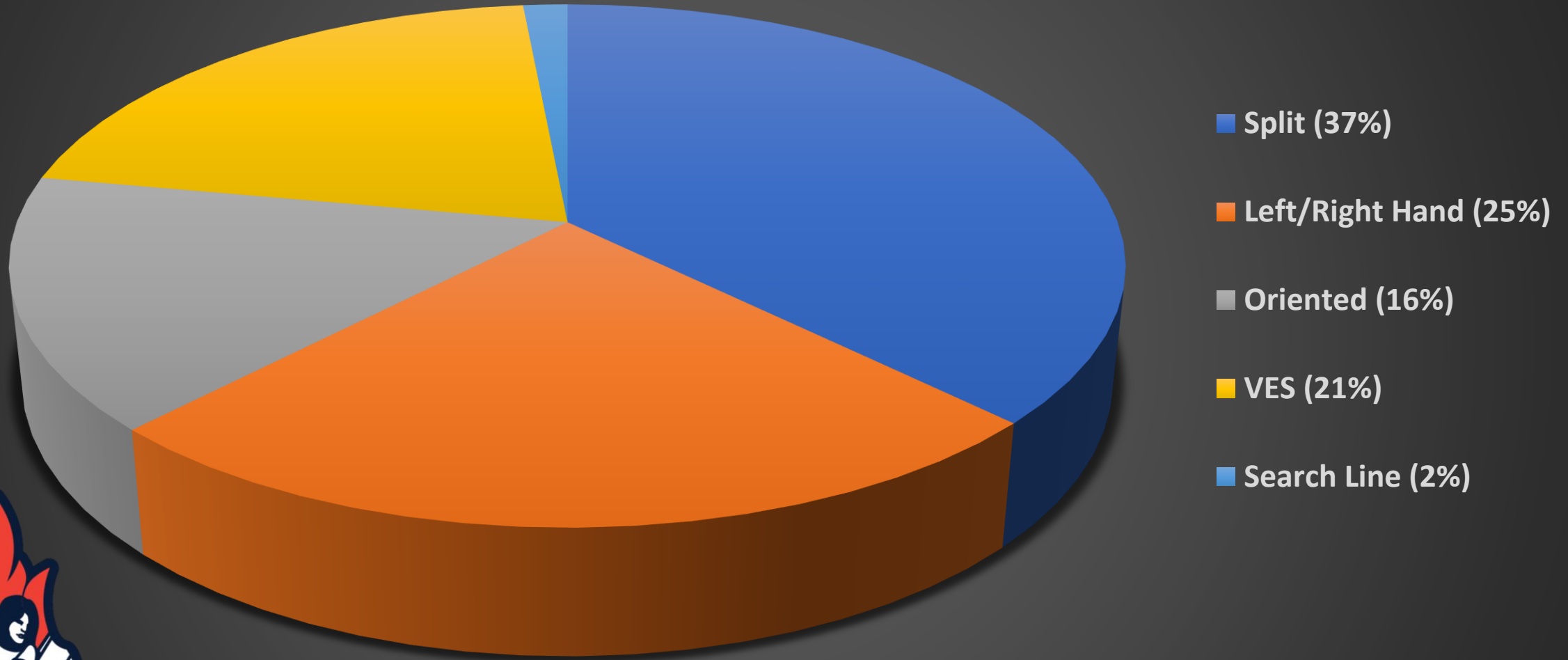

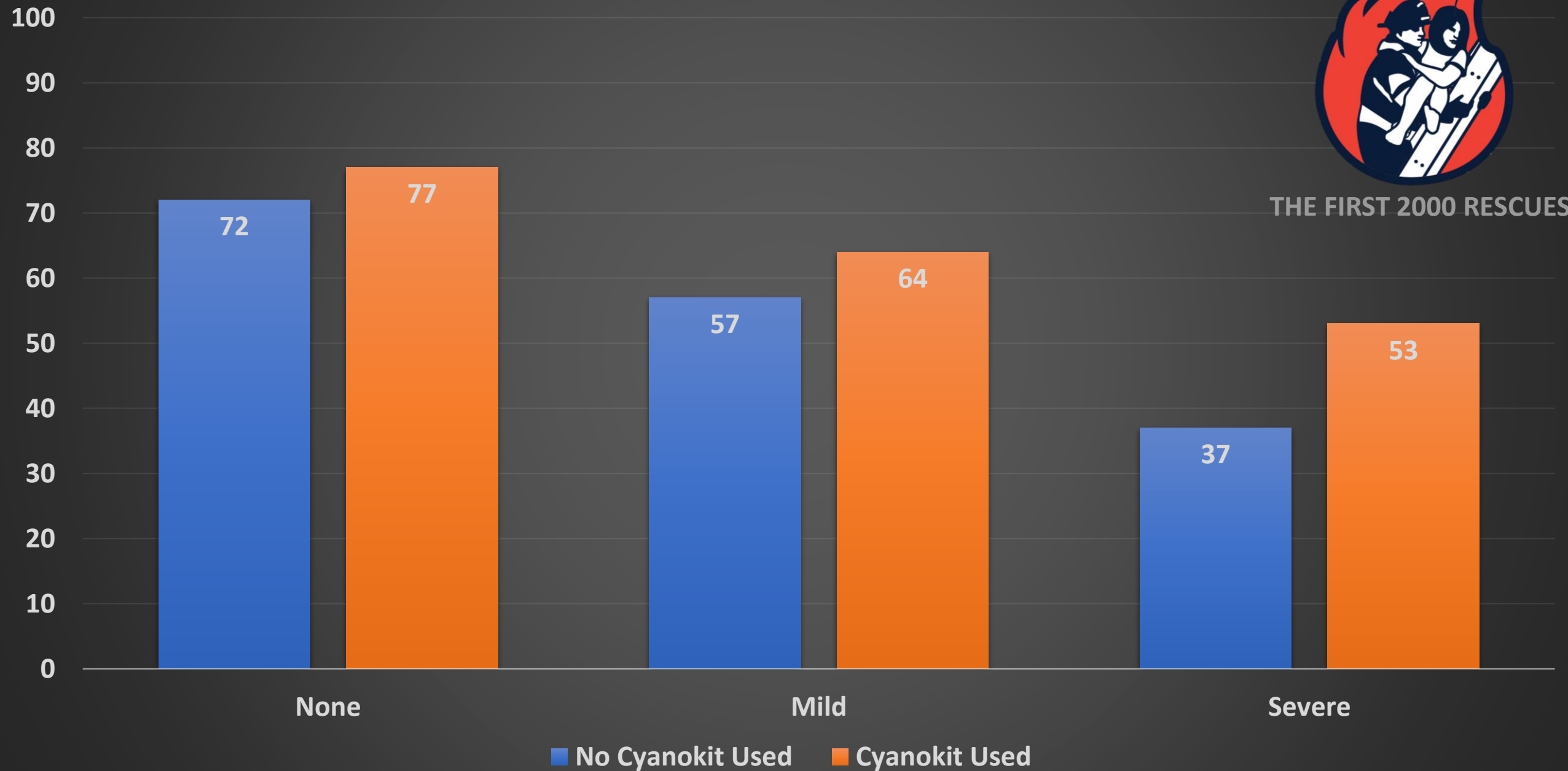

Cyanokit Use and Victim Burns v Survival Rate



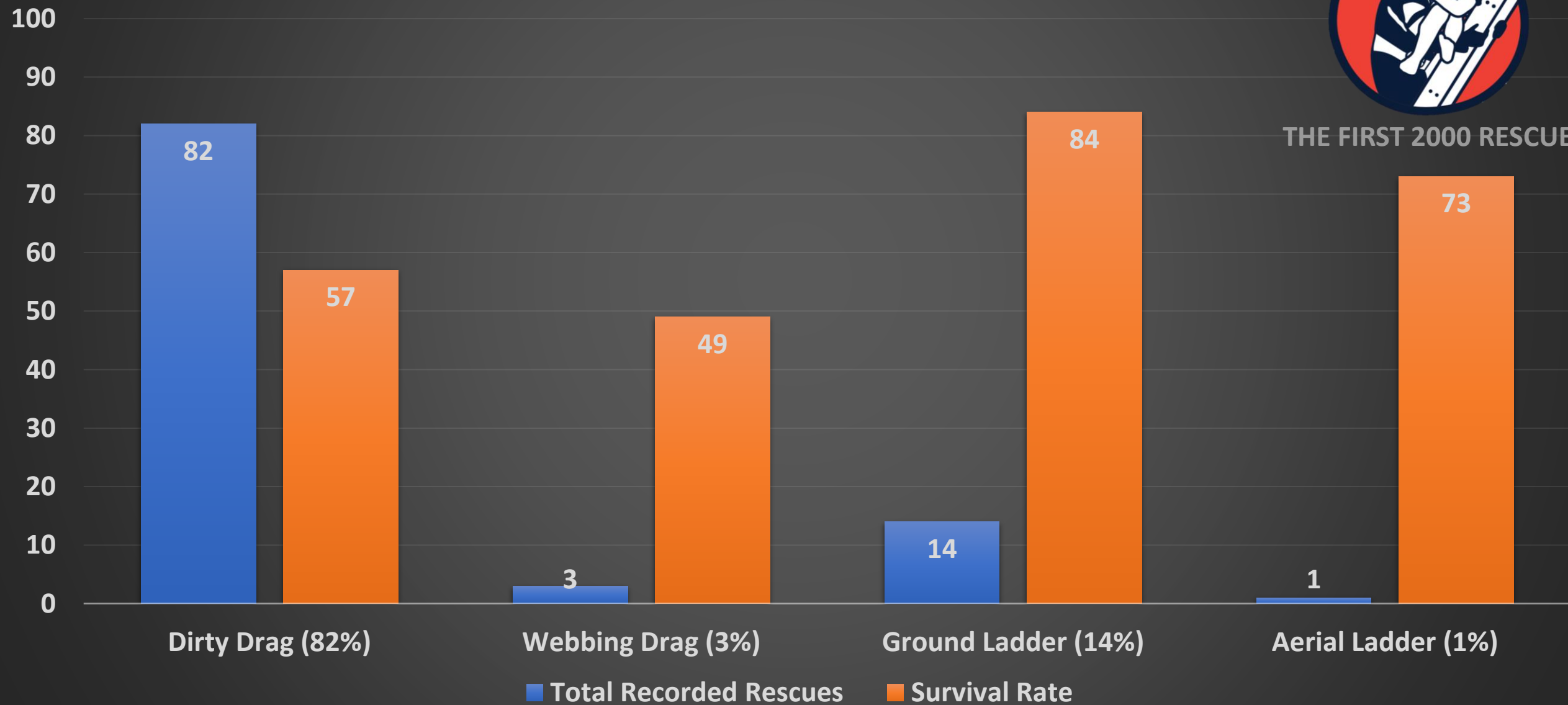

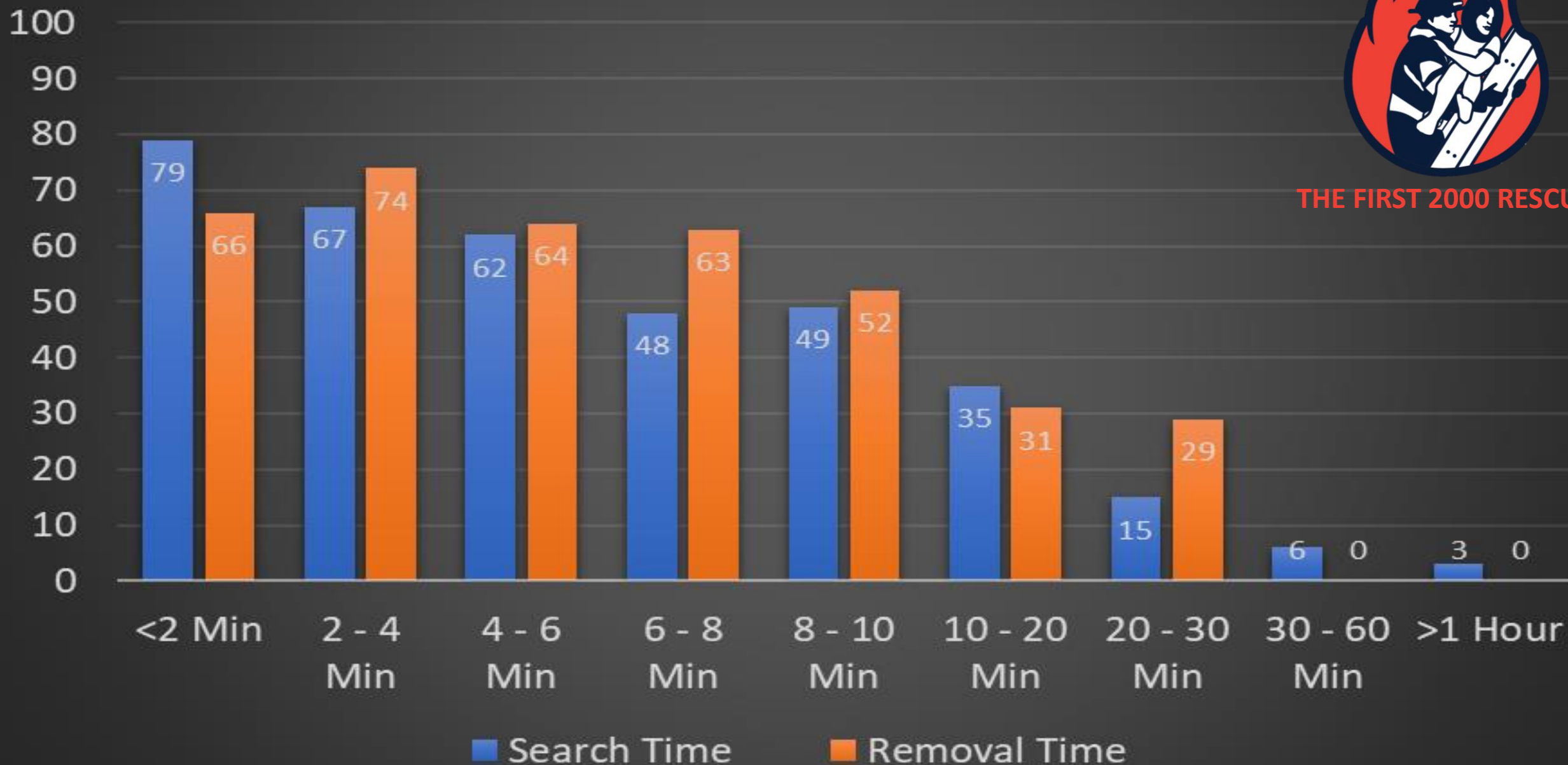
